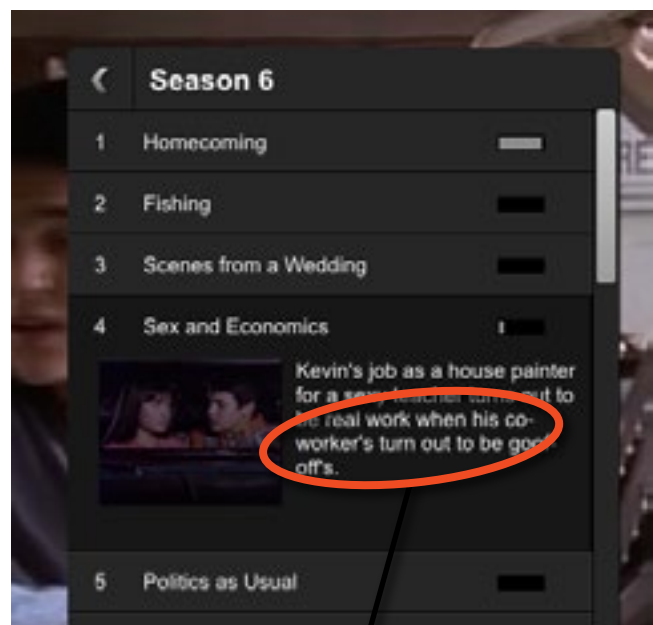

Peshtigo School District

With school aid estimates for the 2012-13 school year recently released on October 15th, the District is now projecting its tax rate to be at \$ 9.41. This compares to \$9.02 a year ago which was well below the state average of \$9.88 for K-12 school districts across the state. State aid to the District has dropped again this year resulting in a local levy increase to meet its revenue authority as provide by law. The School District further reports that the most recent information provided by the Department of Public Instruction show that the total cost per student for the Peshtigo School District is 11.3% below the state average. Other factors effecting revenues and expenditures in school districts are the number of students. The Peshtigo School District has seen an increase of 11 "resident" students and an additional 2 "Open Enrollment" students from the same time last fall. The District's Annual Meeting/Budget Hearing will be held on Monday, October 22nd at 7:00 p.m. in the Peshtigo Elementary Learning Center's cafeteria. The Annual Meeting offers residents an opportunity to provide their input to the Board members and administration of the District.
